

COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT: JARROD ROUNDHEAD'S VISION FOR WELLNESS AND FOOD SECURITY IN SLATE FALLS NATION



Jarrod Roundhead has been serving as a youth outreach worker in Slate Falls Nation and has held the role of Jordan's Principal Worker for the past two years. In that time, he has been developing innovative ways to promote wellness and nutrition in his community.

Inspired by a neighbour's example, Jarrod has launched a unique initiative: a community chicken coop which currently houses 27 chicks. Once the hens begin laying, each household in the community will receive fresh eggs daily. FMG is proud to have supported this simple but impactful step which is already building momentum toward a broader goal.

Looking ahead, Jarrod's long-term goal is to generate enough interest and support to

open a hatchery — potentially becoming the first northern community to establish a fully functioning hatchery that can supply both birds and eggs to neighboring communities in the region.

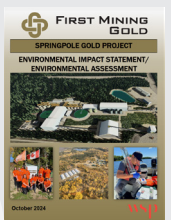
Jarrod shared his motivation behind the project, saying:

"This project is my 'meegwetch' to the community of Slate Falls. The generosity and courtesy First Mining Gold has shown us that with dedication and persistence, we can accomplish many things together."

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT UPDATE

After submitting the final Environmental Impact Statement and Environmental Assessment last November, First Mining Gold has been actively connecting with local communities and government regulators to talk through the findings — everything from technical modelling results to proposed mitigation measures. So far, we've received over 1,700 comments and questions, and our dedicated team of experts is hard at work reviewing and responding to each one. We're excited to keep the conversation going and move forward.

FIRST MINING GOLD PARTICIPATES IN 2025 LAC SEUL CAREER FAIR

SPRINGPOLE ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING UPDATE

The 2025 environmental monitoring program started up in May with FMG staff collecting the Q2 surface water samples consistent with the environmental baseline monitoring program. The team also completed another successful hydrology study and began collecting groundwater data from the 58 monitoring locations installed for the Springpole Project. The data will be used to build on the Project's baseline database and will provide valuable information to inform future permit applications.
